Collection Abstract: The Lufkin Rotary Club was chartered on January 18, 1934 by a group of Lufkin business men interested in providing social services to improve the community of Lufkin and Angelina County. This collection includes minutes, financial records, maps, publications, directories, conference materials, Rotary Ann records, correspondence, clippings, photographs, and artifacts documenting the club's service activities.

Biographical/Historical Note:

The Lufkin Rotary Club was chartered by Rotary International on January 18, 1934. Previously in 1933, Rotary District Governor Charles Ashcroft of Sulphur Springs, Texas, met with W. C. Trout, charter member of the Lufkin Lions Club, Lufkin's first service organization, concerning the organization of a second service club in Lufkin. In the summer of 1933, Ashcroft visited Lufkin and met with Jack McDermott, R. C. Musslewhite, W. D. Newsom, Taylor Clark, Herman Taylor, and Frank Moffett to discuss organizing the Rotary club. At noon on November 6, 1933, in Room 257 of the Hotel Angelina, a group elected the following officers to represent the club: Al Cudlipp – President; R. E. Henry – Vice President; and Jack McDermott – Secretary.

After being chartered in 1934, the club was born at a banquet in the Hotel Angelina's Grand Ballroom on February 18, 1934. At the time, the club became Rotary International's Club 3641. Charter members

with their classifications included: L. D. Barrett, Etra Barington, L. A. Brauer, D. A. Campbell, Al E. Cudlipp, C. L. DuPuy, E. C. Durhan, Curtis M. Everts, Jr., Curtis W. Fenely, Ross Gipson, Allen Henderson, R. E. Henry, R. L. Herbert, Tom E. Huffman, J. W. Kennedy, Harry Kerr, Frank Moffett, Steve Mooney, Jack Mott, J. H. Murrell, R. C. Musslewhite, Jack McDermott, J. W. Pinkerton, George Richardson, W. L. West, and Pete Walton. The club hosted the district conference in 1935.

On January 11, 1936, Lois Barrett hosted a luncheon at the Lufkin Country Club for the purpose of organizing the Rotary Ann Club of Lufkin. Rotary Anns are the wives of male Rotary members. On January 22, 1936, there were 38 Anns, all charter members. Lois Barrett served as President of the Anns through June 1936, followed by Loucile Henderson who served the remainder of that year. At the time, the Rotary Anns of the Dalls Rotary Club were the only other Anns organized in Texas.

The club has shaped the Lufkin community in several ways. The club chartered Boy Scout Troop 130 in 1942, owning and providing a scout house in Chambers Park for use of the troop. The Annual Rotary Waffle bake began in 1956 as a fundraising, community service, and fellowship project. They also held the fundraising and community event American Domino Tournament, including participation from state and national champions. The founding of the Ellen Trout Park Zoo in 1966 was a major club project. A Scholarship and Student Loan Fund was also established in 1966 to assist students attending Angelina College. The Lufkin-Eastbourne exchange was established in 1966. This program sent a youth to Eastbourne, England to spend time in other Rotarians' homes and learn about the area. The Rotary Gallery of East Texas Art was established as a Bicentennial Project in 1976, promoting East Texas art and artists, before being renamed the Rotary Gallery of Art. Other projects aided by the Lufkin Rotary Club have included presentations of Arion Awards and Rotary Scholarships to Lufkin high school students, grants to the East Texas Area Council of Boy Scouts, the Texas Forestry Museum, the Rotary Foundation, and World Community Service. Today the club's objective is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise.

In November 1989, the Lufkin Rotary Club decided to sponsor the formation of a new club in Angelina County. The decision was based upon the recommendations of a committee of fifteen past presidents of the Lufkin club, as well as past District Governor Joe Byrd. The first planning meeting was held January 8, 1990, and the first meeting of the provisional Angelina Rotary Club was on January 25. On March 8, 1990, Will Schrank was elected president, along with C. W. Alexander, vice president; Jim Hunt, treasurer; Jim Wilson, secretary; and Joe Anthony, Sgt.-at-Arms. The directors were J. L. Beard, Art Sayers, John Ross Kay, David Bennett, and Ray Polk. Angelina Rotary Club became a member of Rotary International on April 25, 1990.

Collection Scope and Content:

This collection contains records of the Lufkin Rotary Club spanning from the time of its creation in the early 1930s through the late 1990s. It consists of minutes, financial records, maps, publications, directories, Rotary Ann records, conference materials, clippings, photographs, correspondence, and artifacts documenting the club's social service activities in Lufkin and Angelina County. The records highlight the creation of Boy Scout Troop 130, the annual Waffle Bake, annual and weekly meetings, membership rosters including the Rotary Anns and Angelina County Rotary Club, activities concerning the Ellen Trout Zoo, the Rotary Gallery of East Texas Art, the Group Study Exchange Program, the high school Interact Club Program, and other service events. The bulk of the collection consists of publications such as weekly newsletters, as well as general Rotary International books, booklets, and

song books. There are also membership and attendance records dating 1934-1994. Most of the correspondence is sent or received by L. D. "Bud" Barrett, Lois Barrett, and Ed Wagoner.

Scope and Content: This series contains correspondence relating to the purchase, construction, and renovation of the Scout House, and charters of Boy Scout Troop 130, supported by the Lufkin Rotary Club. Included is the lease from the Lufkin Independent School District for the land where the house was located. Correspondents include E. P. Trout.

Series IV. Rotary Ann Records, 1936-1992

Scope and Content: The Rotary Ann records have been organized into their own series as opposed to interfiling them as a whole with records of the Lufkin Rotary Club. This is because these records were generally grouped together upon accessioning, and original order has been maintained when feasible. These records include minute books, membership directories and yearbooks, financial ledgers, clippings, occasional photographs, and correspondence documenting luncheons, community service projects, advocacy to organizations such as the Girl Scouts, guest speakers at meetings, and changes in leadership, notable members, finances, the Silver Anniversary, the 1957 constitution and by-laws, membership, and the 1946 "Hillbilly" meeting. The meeting materials consist of ribbons and invitations. The records are organized chronologically by date.

Series VI. Publications and Directories, 1937-1997

Scope and Content: This is the largest series of the collection, consisting of general publications of Rotary International, membership directories of the Rotary International District 591 (later 5910), Lufkin Rotary Club, and Angelina Rotary Club, and weekly newsletters of the Lufkin Rotary Club, with a small

amount of newsletters from the District Governor and other clubs. The general publications include song books, a brief history of the Lufkin Rotary Club dated 1937, manuals of procedures, *Service is my Business*, *Seven Paths to Peace*, constitution and by-laws, *Fifty Years of Service*, *Rotarian* magazine, and the *World of Rotary*, Secretary's manuals, and the ABCs of Rotary. Included are several incarnations of the local Lufkin newsletters including *Rotisserie*, *Lufkin Rotarian*, *Lufkin Rotary Today*, *Lufkin Rotary Lookout*, and *Bulletin* (also called *Bull-E-Ton*). The publications are organized chronologically by date.

Series X. Correspondence, 1931-1997

Scope and Content: The correspondence series contains a variety of materials in addition to correspondence. These records were grouped into an over-arching series and designated "correspondence" for lack of a better term. The records can include attendance records, membership

records, letters of resignation, organizational charts, booklets on how to propose new members, occasional annual summaries of events, bylaws, constitutions, brochures, a 1977 report of the International Contact Committee, and proposal to enactment and resolution books. Included is a scrapbook containing clippings from 1951-1952, documenting L. D. Barrett's presidency and activities for those years. The bulk of the correspondence has been organized chronologically by date. Other folders are labeled topically and kept together to maintain original order, as opposed to interfiled chronologically.
