I don't know why they don't write to me.

Have you got those cloths by now? hope you have. we sure are having the nice weather sence the cold spell. we haven't had any rain in a good while, have you all had any rain lately? hope not.

I got a letter from Lillie Tuesday, she said

she was up part of the time, but she was still taking those shots and was feeling better. I was surprised to learn that Emma Dean was up there, maybe her Asthama wont be so bad. I hope she can get her a job in a variety store. She seems like she wants to do something for herself so bad. How long does she intend to stay up there if she dont get a job? Oh yes, I got those papers this week, I sure was glad to get them and I thank you very much for sending them to me. Have you heard wheather Aaron has gone to the Army yet or not? I havent heard from them.

Denverd wrote me that Dorthey had moved across the street from where they were living, how come them to move? guess they got more room. How long was she sick? did you all go  
to the funeral? you all take Care of  
yourselves. let me hear from you real soon.
