had them rec a card from Jacks
wife all so and she said the baby

 twelve pounds and one fourth she
 said the baby sure was fat and
 pretty she is coming in may so
 she said I want to see the baby
 so had Jack come down Ester to
 see me he sure did look well
 has Emma been come back from
 Dallas yet where is Leonard in
 the Army at Bud is at Ft Bliss
 I guess thats where he was the last
 time heard from him although
 I havent heard from him in over
 a month I dont no when we will
 get to come if Lottie takes the
 mumps just when we can I
 wish you could come up to see me
 this war is a full I think you no we
 had no sons in war no! but we
