Sept 11, 1942

Dear mama & Ellis:

I should say I was glad to get you all letter's today and to learn that you all were o.k., hope this will find you all well, I dont feel very good, I have took a bushel of fresh Cold and I dont know what could cause me to take it either.

yes I heated to hear that you all are having so much rain, as it is bad on every-thing except the insects, sure wish we could get that rain up here as it is pretty dry and hot. Hope it dont keep raining

And damage the peanuts and
Cotton.

I sure was worried as I had
just got one letter and the Card
you wrote and the one Ellis wrote
sence I was down there. I
wondered why you all didnt
write me more often than that
as I have written you three
or four letters and a Card
sence I was down there. I am
still worried and wondering
why I dont hear from Dorothy
and them as I havent had
a line from them sence I
was down there. Do you know
why she dont write me? she
may have wrote and I failed
to get it. You didnt say how

they were getting along, O.K. I hope
It make's me feel bad about
the mess Everette got into, looks
like he would have knew better
than that. I feel sorry for Lillie,
but there is not anything we can
do about it. mama, I know that
you have enough to worry about
without worrying about that, so
I hope you wont worry any more
then you can help as you know
it wont do any good. If it done
any good to worry; you know
this war would all be over
and all the men would be at
home with their wives and
all of their folks.

I guess my Cow will come
in very soon any-way, mabe you

All Can sell a little Cream
then. Say Ellis you better fix up
the wagon as you may have to
go to town in it if they start
rationing gasoline and if
you can't get any more tires.
Did you put in an order for two
tires yet? you told me that you
was. you better do it now if you
haven't; maybe you can get them.

I hated to hear that Mr Rhodes
was sick, as he is so old you know.
hope he is O.K. by now.

well, I don't guess you can
ans this letter until I get up
yonder and send you my new
address, we are suppose to leave
here Tuesday morning, so we will
get there before night. I sure would

like to stay here, but I guess
Can't stay at the same place
all the time, I am glad
to stay here this long, as you
know it was a year ago
day the 10th that I came

Say, Ellis did you get your
wood stacked back up? and
was there much of it fell down?
I bet your dog was as glad
to see you as mama and Den
was. Ellis I am sending you that
Kakahi suit, it hasnt been
worn since it was laundered.
Mama, I dont like that Creme
but I used part of it and the small jar
was give to me as I bought a bottle of the
Jergins lotion, I thought you might
like it. I dont have any news, I will write
a card soon. Love, Lenard.

I should say I was very glad to get your letter to-day and to learn that you was O.K. hope this will find you well, I don't feel very good as I have took a bushel of cold, I just can't get well of a bad cold before I take more cold. I don't know what cause it either.

Yes, it was bad about some-stealing my money, but it hurt them worse than it did me.

I sure hate to hear that it is raining so much down there, sure wish we could get

that rain up here as it is
so hot and dry up here.

yes, Emma Dean told me
about sending you those school
supplies, guess you have enough
to last you for quite a while
now. How are you getting along
in school and how do you
like your teacher's? guess you
see Edward most every day on
the bus. Have they said any-
thing about you paying bus fare
yet? hope they don't. I guess Howard
can say a good many words by now.
I haven't heard from them since I was
down there. Have you used any of that
hair shampoo that I sent by Ellis? you
can help mama use some of that creme if
you want too. Guess you cant see this
over

until I send my new address
as we are suppose to move Tuesday, but
I guess ^{we} will get there Tuesday night.
but I will send my address as soon
as I can. Say you better have mama
to get you a rain coat as you
are out in the rain so much.
I dont have any news. One soon.
