Just a line to let you know that I could not get the size in the overalls that you wanted (22) but I had to take a size (14). I hope they fit and I had to get a little different shirt as they didn't have the size you wanted in the one like you sent back, but it is almost like the trousers, it was the same price as the other one you sent back. Guess you got the baskets as I mailed them today. you give Dorthey one of them tell her I sent it to her. you are suppose to use it for a biscuite plate with a cloth in the bottom of the basket. A man gave them to me up here at Amarillo. Hope they are not meshed when you get them. How is Dorthey & family? I don't see why she don't write me. well it has gone three days now without raining. Say Elli's what are you doing now? how much more Cotton did you get? It is pretty cold here now. write me as soon as you get the packages. and real soon, Love, Senard
