Feb 29, 1944

Dear Home folks:

Just a few lines to let you hear from me again, hope this finds you all well, I am about the same with my bad Cold.

Has it rain much sense I was down there? hope not; but I bet it has as I got a Card yesterday from Mrs Prince and she said the weather sure was bad, she wrote it the 25th which was two days after I was down there. I guess they had not heard about me being at home as she never said anything about it and I had rather they would not know it. Say Dennard you need not say anything to Edward about me being at home.

I did not tell you on the Card, but I caught rides from Dallas to Memphis Texas which is about 80 miles from Amarillo and I caught a buss there and come on to Amarillo so you see I made the round trip on about nine dollars.

~~The~~ It rained all day here last Sunday and sleeted and snowed a little here Sunday night and has been pretty cold yesterday and today. Say Ellis have you got your tomato beds

Fixed yet? hope you have, you all sure will have a big job setting the plants out in the bed, wish I could be there to help you. As you know I been a bit blue the past week after being at home, but the time has passed by so quick, it don't seem like it was just a week ago this evening that I was down there.

It was a big day here today as it was pay-day. Say Ellis here is some money, you can use ten dollars to buy some more Cow feed and mama you can use \$18.75 for a war bond as I told you so you <sup>all</sup> would get credit for it, so you have it made out too you, but I was too need the money I could have you to cash it or one of those other bonds for me. The bond and Cow-feed will take \$28.75 and you give Dennard a dollar and give Dorthey the other ten dollars to put in the bank for me at Center as I already have a little down there in the bank.

Say Dennard, did you ever find that fountain pin? hope you did, but if you don't find it I will try too get you another one up here, you write me and let me know. You all be sure and write me as soon as you get this money and letter, take care of yourselves, Ans real soon.
