Oct 24, 1944

Hope you got the Coat O.K, as I mailed it last Saturday night. I didn't need it and it had not been wore sense I had it Cleaned as I told you in my letter. About the radio batterys, hope I can put in my order for them soon after Nov 1st.

Has Ellis heard anymore from the draft board? I sure hope he is deferred. Looks like I will just have to get out of the Army if they get Ellis, but I know they can defer him if they will do it. you know Lee Odaniel is suppose to speak in Amarillo tomorrow night,

I want to go hear him, he is making a tour of Texas speaking against F.D.R. I think I will vote with Odaniel as I think he is doing the right thing. I got my Church letter today as I wrote for it about two weeks ago. Bro Wayne Jones sent it too me. Guess I will join one of the Churches here at Amarillo.

Howe you all got all the peanuts up and all the Corn gathered? hope you have. Guess you all have the Chimney finished by now. How much did Alford charge for building it? guess he feels hard at me about something as I have not heard from him sence I was down there and I have wrote him two or three times. Have you all cut the Cane yet? how tall is it "blue" by now? well Dennard I am expecting those parch peanuts

in a few days, hope they are Cured good.

mama has Dad's moniument Come yet? hope it has. I think Dorthey said they were suppose to deliver it and set it up in place.

Ellis how is your eye by now and has it emproved any sence I was down there? hope it has. Saydenard How is Timpson foot-ball team Coming along? the team here on the field got beat last Saturday night the first time they have been beaten.

Guess I will go to the meeting some the last part of the week as it is going on at the first Baptist Church at town. A preacher from Atlanta Georgia is suppose to do most of the preaching. you all take Care of yourselv's and real soon.
