For and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars, (\$50.00) to us in hand paid, by the Texas Southeastern Railroad Company, we and each of us hereby release and forever discharge from liability said Texas Southeastern Railroad Company, for any and all injuries or injurious results, whether known or unknown, sustained and suffered by R. M. Maberry on or about the 24th, day of July 1909, while in the employment of the said Railroad Company in assisting in the operation of a pile driver while driving piling for a bridge across Boggy Slough, a tributary of the Neches River, in Trinity County, Texas; this receipt to be a full discharge of said Company for all injuries sustained as aforesaid, whether arising or based upon tort or contract, and whereas, the said R. M. Maberry, by and through his attorneys, T. W. Jordan and N. D. Wright, heretofore filed suit against said Texas Southeastern Railroad Company in the District Court of Angelina County, Texas, same being cause No. 2381, on the docket of said court, and the said R. M. Maberry and his attorneys, Messrs. Wright and Jordan, hereby agree to dismiss said suit from the docket of said court, and not further or hereafter prosecute the same; the said Texas Southeastern Railroad Company hereby agrees and obligates itself to pay all costs accrued in said cause, and agrees that same may be dismissed at its cost.
